

Operating instructions for gate barrier

Areas of application

Only instructed persons may operate the gate barrier.
In addition, the operating instructions of the manufacturer must be observed.

Hazards

Risk of injury due to improper use or unintentional movements of the gate barrier
(Risk of being trapped, crushed, sheared, cut, caught, tripped or struck)



Protective measures and rules of conduct

- The operating instructions (operating manual) of the manufacturer must be strictly observed.
- The operators (users, operators) of the gate barrier (machine) must be instructed.
- Operational safety must be guaranteed in every operating condition.
- Safety, protective, signalling and warning devices must not be removed or manipulated.
- The barrier may only be used to control motor vehicle traffic.
- The operator must take appropriate measures to ensure strict separation of motor vehicle and passenger traffic (warning and mandatory signs).
- Ensure that the range of movement of the gate barrier is always kept clear and that there are no persons (children playing) or objects in the range of movement of the gate barrier during its operation.
- Never hold the barrier arm or reach into moving parts.
- Only open/close the gate barrier if you have a clear view of the range of movement of the gate barrier.
- Remote-controlled gate barriers may only be approached after the gate barrier has reached its final "OPEN" (upright) position.
- Fasten control units at a height of ≥ 1.5 m, out of reach of children.
- In the event of a power failure, the gate barrier can be unlocked mechanically.
- Ensure that your gate barrier is regularly tested and serviced and that the safety, protective, signalling and warning devices are checked.
- Close the gate barrier in the event of storm warning and wind forces ≥ 8 Beaufort and switch off the power supply.
- The system must be cleared of snow and ice.

How to act in the event of faults

- Operation must be stopped immediately in the event of identifiable faults or hazards.
- Secure the gate barrier against unauthorised use.
- Maintenance and repairs must only be carried out by an expert (specialist company).

How to act in the event of accidents



- Keep calm!
- Initiate first aid measures, secure accident site
- Report the accident, call the emergency services: 112
